All of our members are committed to serving our community. They continue to receive training on how to ensure the safety of our patients and crew members alike.

As a reminder to our community, The Green Knoll Rescue Squad continues to operate on a completely volunteer basis. In order to ensure EMS services continue through the COVID-19 pandemic, we have taken several precautions in an effort to limit the exposure of the coronavirus to our members and the community. In order to do so, we need the cooperation of the community during this time of crisis. We ask that if you are showing symptoms of COVID-19, to contact your healthcare provider and follow instructions from them. If hospitalization is required, although we are always here to safely transport our citizens to the hospital, we ask that everyone consider the possibility of having family or friends, whom you have already come into contact with, take you. If ever your symptoms become life threatening or you do not have the ability to get definitive medical care on your own, DO NOT hesitate to call 911.

Please recognize that during this time, we are not able to transport anyone other than the patient to the hospital. This is for everyone's safety.

If you need the services of the rescue squad, understand that crew members may show up with masks, goggles, Tyvek suits, and other protective equipment. Do not be alarmed as this is to ensure our members stay healthy in an effort to continue providing our services. We ask that you have conversations with your children so that they do not fear us if they happen to encounter an emergency responder wearing protective equipment.
